## **Vehicle Response Volume**

In 2020, the fleet responded to 1,455 calls for fire, medical and agency support. Of these, P-372 responded to 849 or 58% of all calls. P-372 also represents that greatest cost in maintenance and repairs at 30% among the existing fleet. When vehicles require downtime for service, it can be predicted that these events will impact the fire department's ability to respond to emergencies.
