The Transportation Advisory Committee has spent several months reviewing and considering a public request for adaptation and implementation of a anti Idling bylaw and therefore recommends that council approve the following motion made at regular meeting held on Thursday August 26, 2021:

Moved By Mark Mills, THAT Council direct staff to develop an “anti-Idling” bylaw. Development should entail reviewing municipalities in southern Ontario with similar climate conditions and adapt a draft based on “best practices” for approval of council. The draft should indicate the exceptions required for specialized, commercial and protection services vehicles, and should be presented to council prior to the end of calendar year 2021.

AND FURTHER, in conjunction with the bylaw a plan and budget to implement a public education program by installing signs in strategic locations throughout the town, informing the public of the bylaw and the penalty for violation. In addition, a policy/procedure should be developed for exempt vehicles owned and operated by the Town in order to further mitigate idling through operator guidelines. **Climate change mitigation is a core value in the Town of Cobourg strategic plan.**
