By-law # 047-2021 (Expiry June 7, 2022)
One-year Trial Period
No Parking West Side Henderson Drive

Following are benefits observed during the one-year trial period (outlined in By-law #047-2021) with No Parking on the West side of Henderson Drive.

1. residents adhered to the No Parking signs installed on west side
2. residents made better use of their driveways
3. easier access to front entrances on west side
4. reduced clutter of vehicles on the street
5. proper and thorough snow plowing of street
6. no need for plow to return a second time to complete its job
7. proper and thorough street cleaning
8. garbage pick-up was never missed
9. no juggling of garbage bins between parked cars and snow banks
10. easy access to our front entrance

As an aside, we understand that a by-law prohibiting vehicles from parking longer than 48 hours is being considered. We would strongly support the enforcement of such a by-law to further improve street parking.

Importantly, we are pleased to report that the conditions on Henderson Drive have improved significantly.

We request, therefore, the continuation of No Parking on the West side of Henderson Drive to remain in effect, permanently, after June 7, 2022.
