3. DELEGATION REQUEST
General Nature/Purpose of the Delegation: (Clearly state the nature of the business to be discussed & provide a general summary of the information to be presented) The Memorial Arena may likely accommodate three indoor tennis courts. The dimensions of a doubles court is 78 feet long x 36 feet wide with a total playing area of 2,808 feet. These could also be used as Pickleball Courts which require less playing area. Presently there is no year round courts in this vicinity. The closest is at the Civic Recreation Complex on Thornton Road in Oshawa which has 5 courts. The Oshawa Tennis Club has tried for 6 years to get indoor courts which has been denied. In 2015 the town of Hastings at a cost of 4.8 million opened its multi-purpose bubble facility with one tennis court that converts to 4 pickle ball courts. I cannot supply you with the number of tennis players in the area but besides the Coverdale Courts and Sinclair Courts, the Port Hope Racquet Club has very active tennis programmes for adults and kids. A long time member there advised me that there is possibility of a Toronto source to invest in covering their courts with a winter bubble. I have also been informed that Tennis Canada and Rogers have committed to installing 160 all-year tennis courts. Indoor tennis playing has been overlooked and short-changed in this vicinity. It is a wonderful sport and is popular world wide. Please consider using the Memorial Arena for this purpose.
