### Healthy Smiles Ontario

#### Changes to dental programs in Ontario

On January 1, 2016, the following six publicly funded dental programs were combined into the new Healthy Smiles Ontario program:

- dental benefits for children under Ontario Works
- dental benefits for children under the Ontario Disability Support Program
- dental benefits for children under the Assistance for Children with Severe Disabilities program
- the Children In Need Of Treatment program
- the Healthy Smiles Ontario program
- preventive oral health services provided by local public health units

Children and youth currently receiving care from the programs listed above were automatically transitioned into the new Healthy Smiles Ontario program.

## Canada Dental Benefit

The interim Canada Dental Benefit is intended to help lower dental costs for eligible families earning less than \$90,000 per year. Parents and guardians can apply if the child receiving dental care is under 12 years old and does not have access to a private dental insurance plan.

Depending on your adjusted family net income, a tax-free payment of \$260, \$390, or \$650 is available for each eligible child. This interim dental benefit is only available for 2 periods. You can get a maximum of 2 payments for each eligible child. Benefit payments are administered by the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA).

The first benefit period is for children under 12 years old as of December 1, 2022 who receive dental care between October 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023.

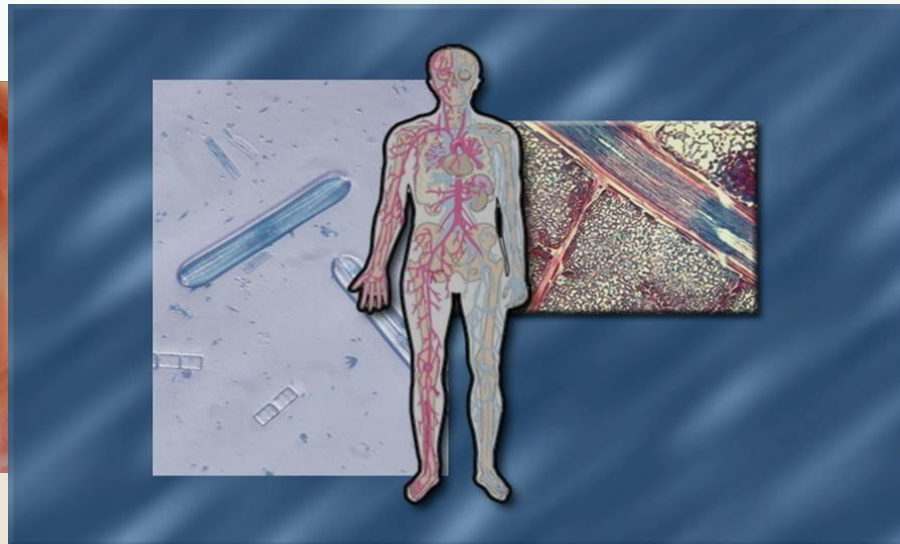
Non-emergency dental services under the Ontario Seniors Dental Care Program are gradually restarting.
