Hi Accessibility Committee, I have a suggestion that I am asking you to consider and possibly act on. I have difficulty seeing the small, faint, coloured print on some web-sites, including our town's web-site.

An example is when you log onto Cobourg.ca and then click the window E-Scribe and scroll down to the heading Municipal Council and Advisory Committee calendar - just below that there is a small window with the word Search. It is that word with light coloured font that I find difficult to see.

The term "it's right there in black and white" has been used for years meaning anyone can see it - it's not intentionally hidden. This is an easy fix. It's not like building a ramp for a store entrance.

Could you ask the Town to be mindful of the print visibility.
