- My tax dollars pay for some things I can't use: skateboard park / bike lanes / trails / marina ~ but I realize we all share. Most anyone can use transit we all pay for. Why is it considered detrimental? 
- The on-call system may have been O.K. during COVID lock down. As school/work/events/business reopen demand increases and the mathematics of a bus system run like a cab becomes more illogical. 
- I've been driven by as many as 4 times waiting for my turn to be picked up. This does not save gas or time. 
- Drivers drop a passenger. They can't pick me up because it's not my turn. They return in 15 mins because my name comes on screen. I could have already been on the bus saving the return trip gas & time to get me. 
- Transit costs taxpayers \$1.67/mo. and we pay fares. The library costs taxpayers \$6.67. Isn't it curious the library is free to all patrons no matter financial ability, & no one complains. 
- Don't saw transit too expensive. Years ago seniors \$55 a month was cut to \$30. Why & only now increased to \$36. Should be at least \$50 now. Why does the card cost \$6? (with no rides on it). Is there a charge for a Tim Card etc? 
- There could be a hybrid system - on call during hours of low demand. Regular service weekdays.

- Don't patch service with school buses. They have stairs no ramps & narrow aisles. They are not accessible. Having a wheelchair lift is not useful to people with canes/walkers/strollers.
- Door-to-Door is great provided Coboura clears the snow out of every curb & off every sidewalk. (Never.)
- The bus assumes every rider has a phone & computer. Not so.
- Book a week ahead or you won't get desired or necessary time. Book return time or you won't get I have to guess how long the drive time/who else are picking up, how long? (I've been driven past my destination to pickup others) Now busy the store~how much time do I need? Guessing causes anxiety. Regular, routed, timed schedule solves this.
- This is not tourist or environmentally friendly. If it worked many town would have this "Bennu Hill Run". I'm tired of asking Dad for a ride. For the first time in my life I wish I could drive. Transit is a civility for all. No city makes money on trans
- Above all our Coboura drivers are the best! They are courteous helpful caring & cheerful. I can not praise them enough.
