Northumberland 89.7: Truly Local Radio

- Northumberland 89.7 FM (call letters CFWN-FM) is a **volunteer operated, not-for-profit** based radio station located at 1000 Elgin Street West, Cobourg, Ontario.
- Northumberland 89.7 FM does not have charitable status. Operations funding comes from grants, donations, advertising and fundraising campaigns.
- Northumberland 89.7 FM provides local news, opinion, events coverage and is the only station to actively encourage and broadcast local artists and local music in Northumberland County.
- Northumberland 89.7 FM broadcasts at 700 watts and a offers a local broadcast area of 50,000+ residents plus internet streaming.
- Winner of the 2016 and 2018 BAA Communication & Technology Award
- Northumberland 89.7 has been operating the Summer Music Series successfully since 2014





Summer Music Series Concerts 2021 Goals

- Increase year over year attendance (target: 250 per evening from 175)
- Offer free, engaging local entertainment for residents and visitors
- Compensate musicians and sound crew for their time and talent
- Create opportunities for local musicians for high-profile local engagement
- Increase visibility for Northumberland 89.7 FM
- Increase quality of show experience and presentation
- Provide sponsor opportunities for local business
- Generate a sense of local pride and community spirit

Summer Music Series Concerts 2021 Management Process

- Application: Band/artist bio and info + MP3 music file for adjudication & evaluation. Completed by March 15, 2020. **2020 booked artists have first right of refusal for 2021
- Evaluation: All applicants are reviewed by programming committee for:
 - > (1) suitability for all ages
 - > (2) diversity of music styles
 - > (3) local musician content
 - (4) professionalism
- Booking: Scheduling artists, generating contracts, communicating expectations, ensuring tech needs, timing
- Promotion & Advertising: Radio promotion, printed posters and rack cards, social media engagement completed & launched by May 31, 2021
- Raffle Lottery License Application: For 2021, N897 will again apply for a Raffle Lottery License to run a 50/50 draw at every concert to offset operating costs

- Municipal Grant Request for \$ 1,500 in cash
- Total Municipal Grant request \$2,300 value
- Cash cost to Town of Cobourg per concert: \$187.50
- Cost to Town per estimated volunteer hour: \$4.03
- Cost to Town per estimated attendee: \$0.75 (target)
