Hi Mr Larmer

I am requesting that council discuss a simple common sense public health measure that is deficient in the current Town of Cobourg property standards bylaws.

Standing stagnant water is a health hazard. West Nile Virus is now endemic in Southern Ontario. Quality of life from May through August is significantly impacted by excess mosquito and blackfly activity. Standing water presents further additional health risks to our pets including giardia and cryptosporidium.

For 5 years we have dealt with excessive mosquito activity due to standing water next to our property. An extensive landscaping project was undertaken that disrupted the natural drainage of the adjacent property.

Every major municipality in Southern Ontario addresses this issue in their property standards bylaws:
