Background

Report to:

The 2023 operating budget of the Cobourg Police Service (exclusive of business center operations) is \$10,017,664. To support this, the service received about \$6.993 from the Town of Cobourg through the Tax Levy. This report provides a draft overview of police financial operations for the first quarter of 2023.

Report Summary

Report:

The **\$10,017,664** approved budget was broken down and approved to be spent in the categories listed below. The fifth column (labelled Actuals) reflects actual spending for the quarter, while the sixth column (labelled percentage of actuals) shows how individual buckets compare to total spent.
