Background:

As indicated in the Cobourg Police Service Strategic Business Plan community engagement is paramount. Specifically, Objective 3.1: Enhance the effectiveness of our communications with the public through our visibility, engagement, education and outreach" speaks to engaging regularly with ongoing community feedback, engaging the community in crime prevention. Further, "Objective 4.3: Be responsive to the changing needs of our community" utilizes the strengths and interests of all members to identify and adapt to areas of concern that are highlighted by community members.

The onset of a worldwide pandemic has created obstacles to actualizing these goals. Report
