



BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE GANARASKA REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY

WHEREAS section 8 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides in part that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers, and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority; and

WHEREAS section 9(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg at its January 10, 2024 Public Works, Planning, and Development Standing Committee Meeting, authorized the Mayor and Municipal Clerk to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ganaraska River Conservation Authority (GRCA) for services based on new legislation introduced by the Province.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COBOURG ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and instructed to execute, on behalf of the Corporation, a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ganaraska River Conservation Authority (GRCA) for services based on new legislation introduced by the Province.
2. THAT this by-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
