DISCUSSION:

Grant of Lease
 Jack Heenan Arena – 25,500 sq ft
 Memorial Arena – 27,000 sq ft

Rent – Jack Heenan is \$7,000/year. Same square feet rate plus inflation.

Term – Up to 20-year term

Conditions - To be reviewed in detail

Right to grant lease – no changes

Non-exclusive use of parking – agreed The Town is looking at the overflow lot for a potential site for affordable housing.

2. Alterations and Additions

Long Term Intent
Building Code – AODA by 2025

ACTION: Invite Building and Planning to one of the meetings.

Signs – A smaller version of the Memorial sign will have to stay on the building.

The Town is open to a Canadian Firefighters Museum sign with appropriate Town approval.

3. Additional Covenants

Major Events – Coordinate with Jack Heenan.

Remove - Follow Municipal Alcohol and Cannabis Policy.

4. Additional Covenants of Landlord

Parking Lot – Tenant looks after walkway.
