1. CALL TO ORDER

His Worship Mayor Henderson called the Meeting to Order at 6:02 P.M.

4. REPORTS

4.1 <u>Municipal Staff Update regarding the January 12, 2021 Provincial</u> <u>Declaration of Emergency/Ontario Regulations and discussion on the Status of the Rotary Harbourfront Park Outdoor Skating Rink.</u>

Tracey Vaughan, Chief Administrative Officer, provided an overview of the provincial stay-at-home order and spoke to the terms and requirements under the order. T. Vaughan highlighted the challenges facing the Town and what is expected under the provincial order. T. Vaughan spoke to the impact of the recent provincial orders on the current the operation of the Rotary Harbourfront Park Outdoor Skating Rink and noted further clarity regarding the provincial lockdown should be forthcoming which may assist in making an informed decision.

Due to technical difficulties, Council took a recess at 6:13 P.M.

Council resumed at 6:22 P.M.

Brent Larmer, Municipal Clerk/ Manager, Legislative Services, spoke to the enforcement of the provincial orders, social distancing protocols and possible restrictions associated with the provincial order.

Teresa Behan, Deputy Director of Community Services, spoke to the operation of the Harbourfront Skating Rink in light provincial order.

Members of Council engaged in a discussion regarding the enforcement of provincial orders and its impact on current operations, risks, challenges and measures for the rink to remain open. Members of Council raised questions regarding the information provided by staff to which T. Vaughan, T. Behan and B. Larmer responded.

Transit Service

Laurie Wills, Director of Public Works, spoke to the operating hours of transit services and possible reduction of ridership in light of provincial orders. L. Wills noted she is seeking direction from Council for the operation of the transit services.

Members of Council engaged in a discussion regarding transit operation hours for conventional and wheel-transit and whether the operating hours should remain status quo.
