BY-LAW NUMBER 066-2024

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH HIS MAJESTY THE KING IN RIGHT OF ONTARIO AS REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND COMMUNITIES FOR THE COBOURG SHORELINE PROTECTION REPAIR PROJECT

WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, ("the Act") as amended, provides a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act or any other Act; and

WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides Municipal power, including the Municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by by-law, unless the Municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

WHEREAS the Government of Canada established the \$2 billion Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund in Budget 2017; and

WHEREAS the Government of Canada established a top up of \$1.375 billion for the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund in Budget 2021; and

WHEREAS the Government of Canada established a top up of \$489.1 million for the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund in the 2022 Government of Canada Adaptation Action Plan; and

WHEREAS the Town of Cobourg has submitted to Canada a proposal for the funding of the Cobourg Shoreline Protection Repair Project which qualifies for support under the Program; and

WHEREAS the Town of Cobourg is responsible to carry out the Project and Canada wishes to provide financial support for the Project and its objectives; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg deems it expedient to enter into an agreement with His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure and Communities for funding the Cobourg Shoreline Protection Repair Project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Cobourg enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council authorize the Mayor and Municipal Clerk, or their respective designates, to execute all documents necessary for the Cobourg Shoreline Protection Repair Project and to affix the corporate seal of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg to all such documents; and
- 2. That this by-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
