



BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 065-2024 THE STORMWATER CHARGE BY-LAW TO EXEMPT THE GANARASKA REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY (GRCA) LANDS

WHEREAS subsection 228 (2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (“Municipal Act”) authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws imposing fees and charges pertaining to a stormwater system pursuant to sections 9, 10, 11 and 391 of the Act; and

WHEREAS the Town of Cobourg passed By-law No. 065-2024 to establish and adopt a stormwater management charge by the Town of Cobourg on December 18, 2024; and

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and expedient to amend the Stormwater Charge By-law to provide an exemption of the charge to the Ganaraska Conservation Area property located at 700 William Street, Cobourg, known municipally and within the Cobourg parks inventory as James Cockburn Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COBOURG ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Appendix A: List of Properties Exempt from Municipal User Fees and Charges be amended to include the following wording:
 3. Ganaraska Conservation Area property located at 700 William Street, Cobourg, known municipally and within the Cobourg parks inventory as James Cockburn Park and that this exemption remain in place only as long as the current MOU between the Town and GRCA is in effect for the use of the lands as a municipal park and open space operated by the Town of Cobourg.
2. That this by-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.

READ and finally passed in Open Council this 29th day of October, 2025.
