1. CALL TO ORDER

4. PRESENTATIONS

4.1 <u>Dean Pepper, Chair, Cobourg Police Services Board and Paul</u> <u>Vandegraaf, Cobourg Police Chief, presenting the Cobourg Police</u> <u>Service 2020 Annual Report.</u>

The presentation highlighted the Cobourg Police Services 2020 Annual Report and provided a review of the pandemic, financials, technological advancements and community engagement as it relates to the policing services P. Vanderdraaf noted the pandemic shifted responsibilities within the policing model, enhanced health/safety protocols and promoted innovation within test pilots. P. Vandergraaf provided a review of the Criminal Investigation Branch (CIB), Forensic Identification Services (FIS) and Crime Statistics for the Town of Cobourg. R. Ramkissoon spoke to the 2020 operating and capital budget for the Cobourg Police Services and provided comments regarding timely financial reporting and strategic financial planning. The presentation concluded with a review of the 2021 objectives for the Cobourg Police Services.

Members of Council raised questions regarding body worn cameras, speed reporting, illicit substance use, enforcement, graffiti and the Cobourg Police Services budget process. In response, P. Vandergraaf spoke to the draw back in speed enforcement due to the pandemic and the establishment of the road safety response team working group. P. Vandergraaf also spoke to the importance of a harm reduction strategy, a long term community safety and well-being plan and graffiti management. D. Pepper provided comments on engaging the public in the Cobourg Police Services budget process.
